AGREED ORDER RECALLING DEATH WARRANT

The Parties conferred to arrange for Mr. Canales's counsel, inter alia, to access and review the State's file maintained in the Special Prosecution Unit's offices in Huntsville, seek further discovery from other law enforcement entities, and continue Mr. Canales's investigation. The Parties further agreed to request the Court to schedule a date for the filing of a subsequent application for a writ of habeas corpus and asked that that deadline be set near the end of September 2023.

The Parties have agreed that Mr. Canales's pending Execution Date of March 29, 2023, should be withdrawn to permit the Defendant to file a Writ of Habeas Corpus and seek additional formal discovery, if permitted.

The Parties have presented the Agreement to the Court in chambers and telephonically on March 15, 2023.

Now Therefore, based upon the Agreement of the Parties, and based upon the inherent authority of the Court to withdraw or modify its orders, the Court ORDERS that Mr. Canales's scheduled March 29, 2023, Execution Date is hereby WITHDRAWN, and the warrant of execution, entered on November 29, 2022, is hereby RECALLED.

The District Clerk of Bowie County shall immediately notify the Director of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Institutional Division, Mr. Bobby Lumpkin of the entry of this Order.


It is further Ordered, that Defendant shall file a subsequent application for a writ of habeas corpus in this Court by September 29, 2023.


