21	corpus vacating the guilty verdict in petitioner's case unless the state commenced a new trial			
22	within a reasonable time. [Doc. 569] Subsequent to that order the state undertook to review the			
23	case and to ascertain the current location of prosecution witnesses to determine whether a retrial			
24	was possible. As a part of that review it was determined that a number of witnesses were

2	that a retrial is not reasonably feasible. Counsel for petitioner has been notified of this decision.			
3	In light of the state's decision to forgo retrial, respondent requests that the writ issue and the			
4	verdict in the murder of Charles Gardner be vacated. Respondent notes that at the time of			
5	Gardner's murder petitioner was serving a life sentence for a prior murder. That conviction			
6	remains intact.
