



The Death Penalty Information Center 2020 Year-End Report: Media Coverage Highlights

The Death Penalty Information Center's [2020 Year End Report](#) was released on December 16, 2020 and received extensive coverage in hundreds of print, online, television, and radio news outlets across the United States and around the world.

The year-end report acknowledged that the deep decline in death sentences and state executions was unquestionably a by-product of the pandemic, but even before the pandemic struck, the nation was on pace for the sixth straight year of near-record low sentences and executions. 2020 — a year unlike any other — featured the combination of court shutdowns from the worst pandemic in more than a century, a national reawakening on racial justice issues, and an unprecedented execution spree by the federal government. Even so, coverage of the year-end report noted that executions and death sentences in the United States fell to historic lows and that the federal government's decision to restart executions in the middle of a pandemic after a 17-year hiatus was historically aberrant and completely out-of-step with today's state death-penalty practices.

An Associated Press story that was carried by over 150 outlets noted that “President Donald Trump oversaw a full-throttle resumption of federal executions this year after a 17-year pause, carrying out 10 executions even as backing for capital punishment waned” and that 2020's execution total was higher “than any other presidency since the 1800s”— a message that DPIC Executive Director Robert Dunham pushed consistently in interviews. Robert was quoted in the Associated Press's article: “We have never seen it before. We never expected to see it. And it may be a long time before we ever see it happen again.”

Robert told the New York Times that “[a]t the time that almost every state was making the safety of its citizens a higher priority than executing prisoners, the federal government decided that it was more important for it to carry out a rash of executions without complete judicial review of those cases in circumstances that placed the public health at risk.”

Robert was featured on NPR several times, including in news stories and as a guest on *1A* and *Here and Now*, which are distributed by 360 and 475 radio stations across the United States, respectively. During his *Here and Now* interview, he said that “[w]e've seen an unparalleled politicization of the Justice Department and the death penalty is part of that. After no one had executed anyone in 17 years, this administration has scheduled more executions for a shorter period of time than at any time in either the 20th or 21st centuries.”

Robert also offered extensive interviews to reporters working locally and in specialty outlets, many of whom focused on the geographic narrowing of the death penalty and its discriminatory use against people of color. In addition, multiple outlets quoted DPIC Senior Director of Research and Special Projects Ngozi Ndulue's statement from the press release: “Racism has always infected the use of the death penalty and this year is no exception. The death penalty — as the most severe punishment — must be part of the efforts to address racism in the criminal legal system as a whole.”
