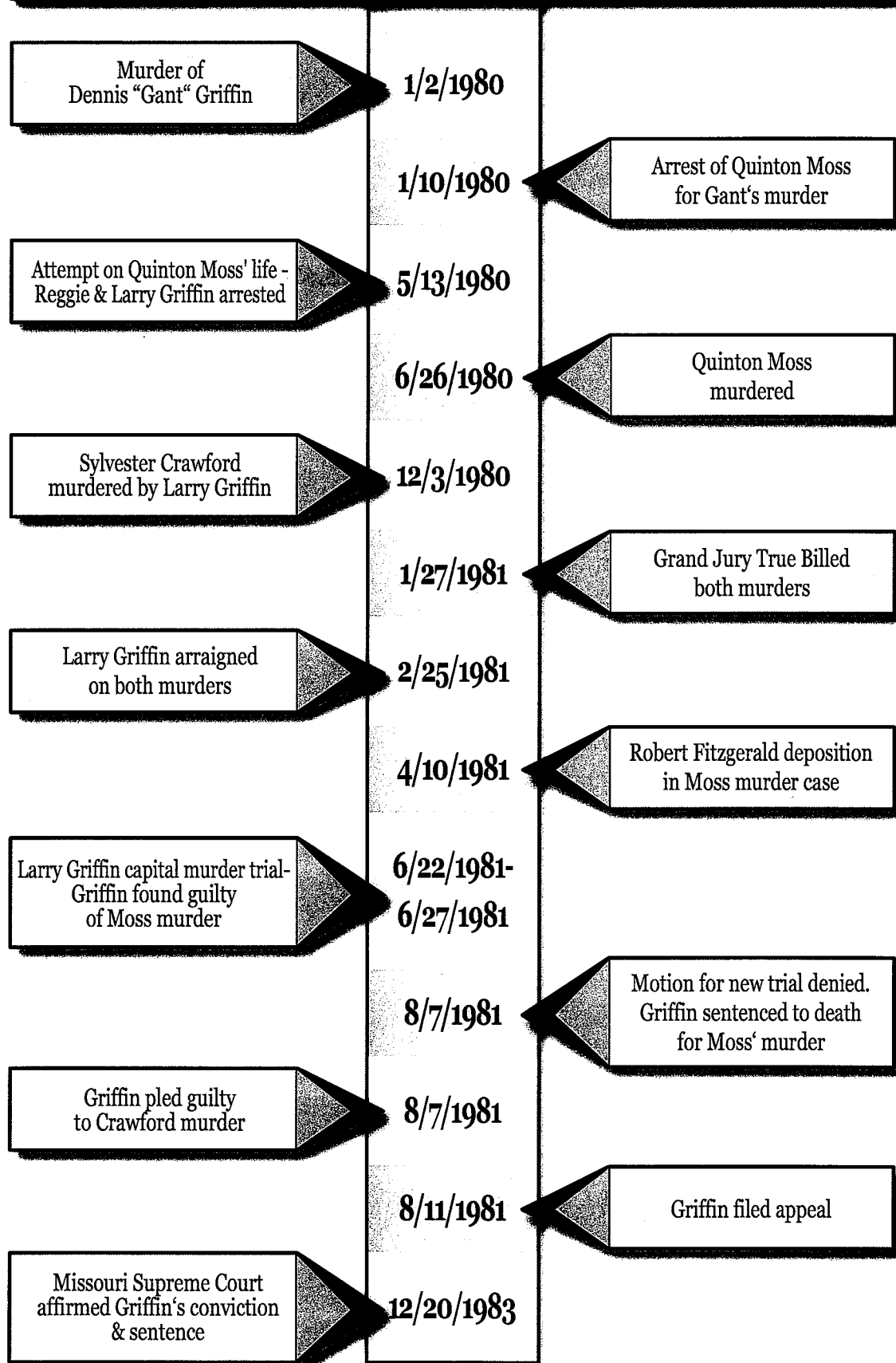

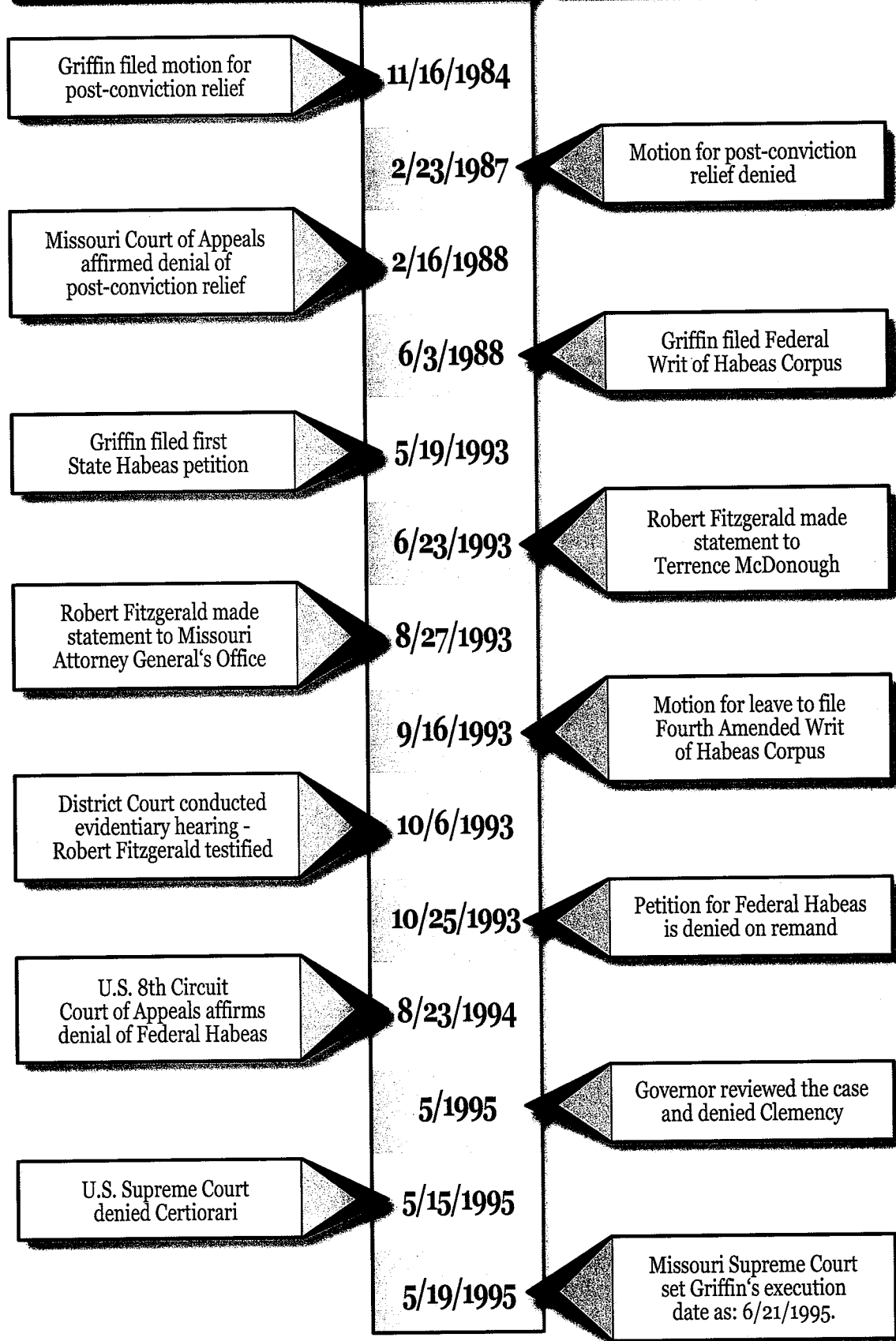

 (2) got into the complex itself and that's when I pulled
 (3) my weapon and I shot George.
 (4) Q And the reasoning was basically for
 (5) fear that he would tell Bennett or Greene?
 (6) A No, that he did that. He actually did
 (7) that. So that was the reason. Because he was
 (8) taking information back from what we were saying to
 (9) Noble. So that was the reason.
 (10) Q Did you ever get arrested for that?
 (11) A No, I didn't.
 (12) Q At the shooting of Shelley, you said
 (13) you were not present at that time?
 (14) A No, I wasn't there when Shelley was
 (15) shot. As a matter of fact, George Noel and I pulled
 (16) up after it happened.
 (17) Q Noel was not there?
 (18) A No, he was not there.
 (19) Q He was with you?
 (20) A We was together.
 (21) Q And you pulled up after it happened
 (22) with George Noel?
 (23) A That I recall, yes.
 (24) Q What happened? What was there when
 (25) you got there?

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- (1)
 (2) A It wasn't anything there. It was like
 (3) later on in that day. We had gone to the robe
 (4) store, call it the robe store. Somehow we found out
 (5) about it. I don't even recall how we found out
 (6) about it. My best recollection was that it was over
 (7) and done with.
 (8) Q When you and Noel pulled up to the
 (9) robe store?
 (10) A I believe that's the way it happened.
 (11) Q Did anybody ever make any statements
 (12) about that shooting to you?
 (13) A Yes. I talked with the parties
 (14) involved. Jerry Lewis-Bey, Darden-Bey, talked to
 (15) Rodney Caven and Noble Bennett.
 (16) Q When you and Noel pulled up to the
 (17) store, were the police there?
 (18) A No one was there when I got there.
 (19) That's what I'm saying, it was done and gone. It
 (20) was over with.
 (21) Q People were talking about it there?
 (22) A I don't know if I got the information
 (23) from there or I got it once I contacted Jerry or how
 (24) I really came about that.
 (25) It was really something that was very

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- (1)
 (2) insignificant. So I just don't remember much about
 (3) that.
 (4) Like I said, I do remember talking to
 (5) Darden-Bey, Carlton Darden-Bey, I talked to Noble, I
 (6) talked to Rodney Caven.
 (7) Q What did Jerry say?
 (8) A That was it.
 (9) Q What did Jerry say?
 (10) A He had pretty much told me that he had
 (11) Carlton shoot Shelley because she had said that he
 (12) was a snitch.
 (13) Q Do you remember what time it was that
 (14) you arrived at the store?
 (15) A No.
 (16) Q Would it have been early evening?
 (17) A I don't recall.
 (18) Q You were there to get Robitussin?
 (19) A Correct.
 (20) Q And then when you and Noel arrived,
 (21) somebody there says to you or somehow you learned at
 (22) the scene that the shooting had happened recently?
 (23) A No.
 (24) Q Well, tell me.
 (25) A I don't know if I learned when I got

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- (1)
 (2) to the store or if it was later. What I am saying
 (3) is when I arrived at the store it was done and over
 (4) with. So I don't know if later when I reconnected
 (5) with Jerry that I found out or someone at the store
 (6) mentioned it. I really don't remember.
 (7) Q But when you got to the store it was
 (8) done and recently over with. I mean, it had
 (9) happened that day?
 (10) A I couldn't even tell you what part of
 (11) the day that it happened.
 (12) All I know is earlier that day I had
 (13) gotten to the robe store and somehow I found out
 (14) that Shelley had been shot. I didn't know any
 (15) circumstances. Like I say, I don't know if I found
 (16) out then or not, I just don't recall.
 (17) Q Noel never told you that he had been
 (18) present when it happened?
 (19) A He never said it to me.
 (20) Q And you all were close?
 (21) A Yes.
 (22) Q Who is George Gervin?
 (23) A George Gervin was an associate of
 (24) ours.
 (25) Q "Associate of ours," ours being whom?

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- (1)
 (2) A Well, I brought him into the fold. So
 (3) he was an associate of myself, Jerry, Stuart Bey,
 (4) Darden Rush-Bey, everybody that was involved in our
 (5) organization.
 (6) Q What year would it have been that you
 (7) brought him into the fold?
 (8) A About '80, '81.
 (9) Q Do you know Cary Caldwell?
 (10) A Yes.
 (11) Q How far back do you and Cary Caldwell
 (12) go?
 (13) A I first met Cary in approximately '79,
 (14) '80.
 (15) Q On the streets?
 (16) A On the streets, yes.
 (17) Q Do you know when Cary Caldwell would
 (18) have first met Jerry Lewis-Bey, if ever?
 (19) A Yes. My understanding was that he was
 (20) introduced to Jerry Lewis-Bey through Michael
 (21) Sheppard-Bey.
 (22) I would say about '89, '90, somewhere
 (23) around there.
 (24) Q Did Cary Caldwell know Jerry Lewis-Bey
 (25) back in the early '80's?

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- (1)
 (2) A Personally?
 (3) Q Yes.
 (4) A Well, he knew of him through me.
 (5) Did he know him personally? I don't
 (6) know if he did or not.
 (7) Q Would you have known if he did?
 (8) A I mean, I was never present when Cary
 (9) was with Jerry or I never seen Cary and Jerry
 (10) present, if that's what you are asking me.
 (11) Q What about Reggie Griffin, did you
 (12) know him?
 (13) A Yes.
 (14) Q Larry Griffin, did you know him?
 (15) A Yes.
 (16) Q How did you know them?
 (17) A Reggie Griffin worked for us and Larry
 (18) Griffin was Reggie's uncle.
 (19) Larry secured some weapons for us at
 (20) one time. And that was basically the gist of our
 (21) relationship. But Reggie and I was pretty close.
 (22) Q Do you know if George Gervin killed
 (23) someone at a Jack-In-The-Box that was going to
 (24) testify against Reggie Griffin?
 (25) A Yes.

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- (1)
 (2) Q He did?
 (3) A Yes.
 (4) Q How do you know?
 (5) A I talked with him.
 (6) Q Were you present?
 (7) A No.
 (8) Q Did Cary Caldwell have anything to do
 (9) with that?
 (10) A No, he didn't.
 (11) Q How do you know?
 (12) A Because I talked to the parties
 (13) involved.
 (14) Q Did Cary ever say he didn't have
 (15) anything to do with it?
 (16) A As a matter of fact, I believe Cary
 (17) said he had something to do with it, but I would
 (18) also like to say maybe he did, I wasn't there.
 (19) Q Quinten Moss.
 (20) Did I ask you about Quinten Moss?
 (21) A No, you didn't ask me about him, but I
 (22) know about him.
 (23) Q Who is he?
 (24) A Quinten Moss allegedly had something
 (25) to do with the murder of Gantz, which was Reggie's

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- (1)
 (2) uncle.
 (3) Q Do you know how he came to be killed,
 (4) Quinten Moss?
 (5) A Yes.
 (6) Q Did you have anything to do with it?
 (7) A Yes, I did.
 (8) Q Can you tell me what your involvement
 (9) was?
 (10) A I am trying to remember that
 (11) situation.
 (12) I had gotten Reggie, I think it was
 (13) Reggie, Russell Watson. It may have been Darrell
 (14) Smith.
 (15) Anyway, the guy was killed up on
 (16) Serral. He was sitting down on a wall doing drugs.
 (17) Q Were you present?
 (18) A Yes.
 (19) Q Did you shoot him?
 (20) A No, I didn't.
 (21) Q What did you do?
 (22) A I was just in the car. I believe, we
 (23) really wasn't looking for Quinten at the time. I
 (24) believe we were looking for the guy called Black,
 (25) something at the time, because I was trying to help

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- (1)
 (2) Reggie out with his situation about his uncle.
 (3) My recollection on this is very vague.
 (4) So.
 (5) Q Did Cary Caldwell have anything to do
 (6) with it?
 (7) A By anything, what do you mean?
 (8) Q Help in any way, tell anybody where
 (9) the guy was going to be, provide a weapon, look out?
 (10) A You see, that's possible because he
 (11) may have told Reggie something.
 (12) Q But I mean you know who Quinten Moss
 (13) was?
 (14) A I knew who he was.
 (15) Q You are saying you were present when
 (16) he was killed?
 (17) A Yes.
 (18) Q Was Larry Griffin present when he was
 (19) killed?
 (20) A No.
 (21) Q You are sure?
 (22) A No, I'm not.
 (23) Q To your recollection, was Larry
 (24) Griffin present?
 (25) A I don't remember.

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- (1)
 (2) You see, you are pretty much talking
 (3) about an incident that I really - I mean, this may
 (4) sound somewhat out of line, but it was just a
 (5) situation where I wasn't involved in, but I didn't
 (6) pretty much care what was taking place at the time.
 (7) And the parties involved didn't mean anything to me.
 (8) So my recollection only is just, I
 (9) mean, it's very vague. For a better term, it just
 (10) was an insignificant incident and it didn't -
 (11) Q Was it like a drive-by shooting?
 (12) A Basically, yes.
 (13) Q You are saying Reggie, you are saying
 (14) Larry Griffin did it?
 (15) A To my best recollection, I'm not sure,
 (16) man. That's what I'm going to say, to be honest,
 (17) because I could be wrong. It's just so vague, I
 (18) don't remember.
 (19) Q After you began cooperating, were you
 (20) ever questioned about the Quinten Moss killing?
 (21) A That's possible. I don't remember.
 (22) You know, it's so many things that a
 (23) lot of times you ask me questions and certain things
 (24) that you may say may bring things to my remembrance
 (25) that I may not have mentioned because you have got

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- (1)
 (2) to understand something, you are talking about over
 (3) 20 years of incidents, information and I'm doing my
 (4) best.
 (5) So I don't know.
 (6) Q Okay. And I think Ms. Leftwich asked
 (7) you about killings you actually did.
 (8) I think you started basically with
 (9) Boykins and Busher. There were others before that?
 (10) A No. That was the first time.
 (11) Q Even ones that you were involved in
 (12) but didn't actually do the killing?
 (13) A That I was involved in, murders?
 (14) Q Yes.
 (15) A I was never involved in a murder.
 (16) Q Of anybody before?
 (17) A I was involved in some shootings, but
 (18) no murders that I recall.
 (19) Q What about a Henry Trotter?
 (20) A Oh, yes. I didn't do that.
 (21) Q Walter McCoy?
 (22) A Did I kill Walter McCoy?
 (23) Q Yes.
 (24) A No.
 (25) Q But thinking about it any more, are

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- (1)
 (2) you able to say whether Larry Griffin was present
 (3) when Quinten Moss was killed?
 (4) A I don't know.
 (5) Q You don't recall is the question?
 (6) A No, I don't.
 (7) Q Did you ever, back in '79 or '80, take
 (8) Cary Caldwell to Jerry Lewis-Bey's house?
 (9) A No.
 (10) Q Even to tell him wait out in the car
 (11) or anything like that?
 (12) A No.
 (13) Q That didn't happen?
 (14) A No.
 (15) Q And you never took Cary Caldwell to
 (16) his house, either Black Jack or anyone else and told
 (17) him to wait out in the car, in '79 or '80?
 (18) A No.
 (19) Q Did you ever tell Caldwell before
 (20) '85 - well, was Cary Caldwell somebody you would
 (21) talk about the killings with?
 (22) A No.
 (23) Q Did you ever tell Caldwell before 1985
 (24) that you were going to kill Robert Young?
 (25) A No.

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- (1)
 (2) Q The car that you say you were in when
 (3) Quinten Moss was killed, whose car was it?
 (4) A I think it was mine.
 (5) Q Do you remember what kind it was?
 (6) A Something like a '68, '69 Chevy,
 (7) something like that.
 (8) Q Baha?
 (9) A That's what we called it.
 (10) Q A four door?
 (11) A Yes, I believe it was.
 (12) Q I assume Cary Caldwell didn't ask you
 (13) to let him use that car for Quinten Moss' killing?
 (14) A No.
 (15) Q Did Caldwell ever drive that car, to
 (16) your recollection?
 (17) A I don't know, because a lot of times I
 (18) wasn't in possession of the car. Reggie would have
 (19) it. So it's possible.
 (20) Q Was Henry Scott one of the people in
 (21) the car at the time that Quinten Moss was killed?
 (22) A I don't know.
 (23) Q Do you know of any murders that Cary
 (24) Caldwell was involved in?
 (25) A No.

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- (1)
 (2) Q Were you ever in St. Mary's Honor
 (3) Center when Cindy Watkins was also there?
 (4) A In St. Mary's?
 (5) Q Yes.
 (6) A Cindy was in St. Mary's, but I wasn't
 (7) in St. Mary's at the same time.
 (8) Q Was there a shooting incident
 (9) involving her?
 (10) A Yes, there was.
 (11) Q Can you tell me about that?
 (12) A Yes. I forgot about that one.
 (13) Let me put it together. Something had
 (14) taken place and it was some threats made by Cindy
 (15) towards me and I basically just went to scare Cindy.
 (16) I shot her.
 (17) Q What year?
 (18) A I don't even know. I got out in '86,
 (19) went back in '86. I don't know, '87. I don't
 (20) remember.
 (21) Q You talked about shooting Noel in
 (22) 1980?
 (23) A Yes.
 (24) Q In 1987 or 1988, did you ever sell
 (25) heroin to George Noel?

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- (1)
 (2) A Yes.
 (3) Q How and where?
 (4) A That was in 1987. He came to an
 (5) apartment that I had with a lady friend of mine over
 (6) on West Norris. The initial deal was made through
 (7) Jerry. And Jerry instructed me to deal with George
 (8) and what to sell George. And that's where it took
 (9) place.
 (10) Q By that time everything was patched
 (11) up?
 (12) A I guess you could say that.
 (13) Q The reason for shooting Noel back in
 (14) '80 didn't have anything to do with him not
 (15) embracing the Moorish religion or anything, did it?
 (16) A No.
 (17) Q Did you ever say that to Noel?
 (18) A Say what to Noel?
 (19) Q That he was shot because he didn't
 (20) embrace the Moorish religion?
 (21) A No, I never said that.
 (22) Q Do you know of any reason why Noel
 (23) would think that?
 (24) A No, I don't.
 (25) Q On Robert Young, did you ever see

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- (1)
 (2) Robert Young and Jerry Lewis-Bey argue while you
 (3) were in prison?
 (4) A I didn't see the argument. I was told
 (5) about the argument, but I wasn't there. That was
 (6) the reason that Jerry was there.
 (7) Q What facility?
 (8) A I was at the church farm, I was
 (9) involved in the security, part of the major
 (10) security. Robert Young was working out on the
 (11) grounds when Jerry came to visit me and they had
 (12) some words.
 (13) Q Who told you about that?
 (14) A At the time of the visit, Jerry told
 (15) me.
 (16) He said basically at the time when they
 (17) pulled up, they encountered Robert Young and they
 (18) had some words.
 (19) Q Anything more than that?
 (20) A No more than that. That's all that I
 (21) recall.
 (22) Q Did you go to Theodore Freyman's's
 (23) funeral?
 (24) A Yes.
 (25) Q Do you remember when that was?

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- (1)
 (2) A Yes, that was in '85.
 (3) Q How was he killed?
 (4) A He was shot.
 (5) Q By whom?
 (6) A Geez, I forget the guy's name.
 (7) Q Was the guy working with somebody else
 (8) or what was it over, do you know?
 (9) A I think the guy was tied to people
 (10) that had killed Rodney Caven. And that was it.
 (11) Q Were there any statements made at his
 (12) funeral or any discussions about anything at the
 (13) funeral, any discussions about criminal activity at
 (14) the funeral there?
 (15) A If there was, I don't remember.
 (16) Q Did you ever supply Earl Parnell with
 (17) cocaine?
 (18) A Yes.
 (19) Q About how many times?
 (20) A I don't recall. More than once.
 (21) Q You said in June of '85 you got out on
 (22) your conditional release date and you were bonded
 (23) out on the Young homicide?
 (24) A I think that I was released from the
 (25) Missouri State Penitentiary somewhere in April or

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- (1)
 (2) May. And I made bond once I was turned back over to
 (3) the St. Louis Police Department. I think that
 (4) probably was around June.
 (5) Q When you got out, where did you go to
 (6) live?
 (7) A I think I immediately went over on
 (8) Vera.
 (9) Q Which is where Cindy Watkins lived?
 (10) A Cindy Watkins didn't live on Vera.
 (11) Q Who lived on Vera?
 (12) A Adrian Westfeld and Veronica Ross.
 (13) But you are talking two different places, two
 (14) different times.
 (15) Q Did Cindy Watkins live on Vera at some
 (16) point in time?
 (17) A Not that I know of.
 (18) Q When you got out, I think you have
 (19) said, did you buy a vehicle?
 (20) A Yes. Bought a couple of vehicles.
 (21) Q Can you tell me about that, where did
 (22) you buy them, from whom?
 (23) A Bought some vehicles, it was off some
 (24) dealer off of North Florissant. I don't recall the
 (25) name of the dealer.
